Location: The Royal Hampshire County Hospital, Winchester, Hampshire

Project Value: £190,000.

Project Vision:

Replacement of Main Hospital Street Corridor Doors: The project consisted of the replacement of the doors, frames and sidelights throughout the main hospital street corridor. This totalled thirty three independent sets of doors located across three separate storeys.

Altus Andrews were appointed to survey and schedule the existing doors, frames and ironmongery and prepare details with budget costs for their replacement. It was a stipulation of the brief that the replacement programme would have to be undertaken on a rolling programme ensuring that safe public access was maintained throughout the works.

Having produced the above details during the summer of 2008, the project was put on hold by the trust as the required funding was not available at that time. The trust are hoping to continue and complete the works during the 2009 / 2010 funding period.
