

Case Study

Location: Wandle Park Regeneration, Croydon.

Project Value: £905,000.

Project Partners: Planning & Transportation Department, Croydon Council.

Quantity Surveyor: Altus Andrews.

Project Vision:

Wandle Park is an urban park which covers an area of 21 acres, or 8.5 hectares. Plans for the park are to include an improvement of existing access, enhancement of existing wildlife habitats; improvement of the landscaping and the redesign and installation of new park furniture, play equipment, kiosks, seating, lighting and public art. In addition the council wish to undertake a restoration of part of the River Wandle, which currently runs under the park through an existing culvert, therefore providing a central feature to the scheme. Existing facilities such as the sports pitches and the skate park are also considered for improvement as part of the overall scheme.

Altus Andrews have provided all Cost Planning services in readiness for Croydon Council's Stage 1 bid to the Heritage Lottery Fund.
